- 1. Developments in contemporary theory over the past decades have led to a reevaluation of the traditional literary canon. Discussion may include **but is not limited** by the following: an account of its history or of its major exponents; a consideration of the main intellectual or social problems that your chosen theory seeks to address; a general description of the ways which such theory approaches a text; the ways in which it might have opened up new interpretive possibilities for the future; a reflection on the intellectual or practical impact that your chosen theoretical model has had in studying or writing about literature.

1. W. B. Yeats is one of the most important poets in modern times. Please explain the significance and characteristics of his poetry, and also do the *explication de texte* (close and detailed textual analysis) of the following poem "Leda and the Swan": (20%)

A sudden blow: the great wings beating still Above the staggering girl, her thighs caressed By the dark webs, her nape caught in his bill, He holds her helpless breast upon his breast.

How can those terrified vague fingers push The feathered glory from her loosening thighs? And how can body, laid in that white rush, But feel the strange heart beating where it lies?

A shudder in the loins engenders there
The broken wall, the burning roof and tower
And Agamemnon dead.

Being so caught up,
So mastered by the brute blood of the air,
Did she put on his knowledge with his power
Before the indifferent beak could let her drop?

- 2. How do you define "high comedy" and "low comedy"? Do an analysis on the comic elements in one high comedy and one low comedy of your choice. (20%)
