 - b. * To who've they been talking?
- 5. a. Do you feel better?
 - b. * Feel you better?
- VI. Consider the following sets of sentences taken from Radford et al. (1999) and decide whether (a) or (b) or both entail (c). What insight(s) does this set of data provide into the meanings of the verbs involved? (15%)
- 1. a. Smith knows that trupids are a type of kontel.
 - b. Smith doesn't know that trupids are a type of kontel.
 - c. Trupids are a type of kontel.
- 2. a. Brown believes that prons grow on fargets.
 - b. Brown doesn't believe that prons grow on fargets.
 - c. Prons grow on fargets.
- 3. a. Green maintains that byfters eat mung.
 - b. Green doesn't maintain that byfters eat mung.
 - c. Byfters eat mung.
- 4. a. Jones recognizes that pogballs make you greep.
 - b. Jones doesn't recognize that pogballs make you greep.
 - c. Pogballs make you greep.
