# IV. Translation (英翻中): Please translate the following English paragraph into Chinese. (25%)

By the early 21<sup>st</sup> century, China had emerged as a highly lucrative, but unpredictable and controversial, market. One of the world's oldest civilizations, mainland China had been a significant economic player in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, at one time representing 33% of global gross domestic product (GDP); but political turmoil throughout much of the 20<sup>th</sup> century had reduced the economy to less than 2% global GDP by 1990. By 2004, however, that poor output was a thing of the past, with vigorous economic growth in 2003 and a GDP that had climbed to 9.1% in that year. (15%)

A first mover to the market may face considerable uncertainty about what product features customers will desire and how much they will be willing to pay for them. For a very new product technology, market research may be of little help. Customers may have little idea of the value of the technology or the role it would play in their lives. (10%)

# V. Business Case and Report Write-up: Read the following business case and write up a report to be presented to the board of directors of the focal company. (25%)

You are a senior manager at House & Home, a chain of warehouse-style stores selling furniture and fittings for the home. The company is suffering. Competition from other similar stores is strong and sales are falling. You think that the main reason for the loss of sales is poor customer service. To find out more about the problem, you asked your customers for feedback. The following complaints were the most common:

- •Staff gave wrong information to me.
- •Staff didn't know anything about the products.
- •Staff were not interested in my query.
- •Staff were rude to me.
- Sales staff were busy talking to each other.
- It was difficult to find help even when the store wasn't busy.
